[Nearest transportation]

If you are using the JR Sobu Line: Approximately 3 minutes walk from the north exit of Kinshicho Station, inside Kinshi Park

If using the Tokyo Metro Hanzomon Line: 2-minute walk from Exit 4 of Kinshicho Station, inside Kinshi Park

If you take the bus, get off at "Kinshi Park (To 02, To 08, Nishiki 37, Nishiki 40)" and walk for about 2 minutes.

[Parking information]

Parking Fee 100 yen per 30 minutes on weekdays and 200 yen on weekends and holidays.

Individuals using the gymnasium can use it for free for up to two hours.

*For group use, up to 5 vehicles can be parked free of charge for up to 2 hours on weekdays, and up to 3 vehicles on weekends and holidays. This 2-hour free parking service is not available to participants or spectators of various tournaments held at the gymnasium.

*Accessibility for people with disabilities: Parking is free for people with disabilities (except on days when the facility is closed).

Please present proof of disability, such as a disability certificate, at the general reception desk on the 2nd floor.

Number of units 100 cars *There is a limit to the number of cars for group users. *Vehicle height is limited to 2.1m.

*Parking is limited, so please use public transportation.

*Please refrain from nuisance parking on surrounding roads or unauthorized parking at nearby facilities.

•All supports and head guards Please bring your own. * Only do-ate equipment is available for rental for beginner classes for children and 1st to 3rd grade elementary school students.


Men are not allowed to wear T-shirts.

– Chest guards for women must be thin and cover only the chest area.

•For the general division (beginner, intermediate, master, women), karate gloves will be required. Please bring your own.

•Wearing a mask is optional for all classes.

[Kumite Win/Loss]

1-point victory: When you land a valid technique and your opponent falls (if they are on their knees and can't get up).

- If you score two waza-ari

Technique Arrives: When a successful technique is landed and the opponent is severely knocked out by the damage.

Also, if the movement stops temporarily.

- When the technique lands cleanly when there is no guard.

(Invalid if only pressed, touched, or grazed)

- When you cut the supporting leg, the opponent falls, and the technique is executed with a sense of zanshin and great spirit.

Effective: A punch or kick that hits the target accurately and causes damage.

- Thrust attacks (hits to the face, neck, or groin are illegal)

- Foot attacks (high knee kicks and groin strikes are illegal)

- Elbow strikes to the torso (horizontal elbows, vertical elbows) are permitted only in the general division (attacks to the face are considered a foul).

- Attack and take the opponent out of the ring

Foul play - Knee kicks to the upper level are prohibited in all classes.

- Attacks to the groin (lower abdomen)
- Attacks on a fallen opponent
- Attacks to the back or back of the head

- Grabbing, throwing, knocking down, pushing with both hands (only techniques that cut the supporting foot at a low level are allowed)

- Attacking by placing your head against the opponent

*For fouls, two warnings will result in a deduction of one point, and two will result in disqualification.

*If a false report is made that a technique such as a knee kick has hit the abdomen or the groin, the fighter will be disqualified and lose.

Judgment criteria (order of importance of judgment: 1>2>3>4)

1. Ippon/Waza-ari > 2. Damage > 3. Accurate effective hit > 4. Number of moves and feet

[Type]

- Flow of the game

Enter → Bow → Say the name of the kata → Ready (preparation) → Start at the athlete's will (if the start is too long, the referee will give the signal to start)

Matches are held one at a time. In the event of a draw, the other person must challenge a different kata. (If the same kata is used, points will be deducted.)

Judging will be by flag, just like in kumite.

- Judgment criteria: Order of importance of judgment: 1>2>3>4

1 posture(Blur), tempo(Contrast), facial expressions, breathing > 2 etiquette(demeanor, spirit, voice)>3 Accuracy and

practicality(Strength)>4 Correct order(order)

*If you do not bow at the beginning or end after entering the court, you will be penalized points.

Formal wear

Masks are removed during matches, and women are only allowed to wear white T-shirts under their uniforms.

Boys are not allowed to wear T-shirts, and if their hair is shoulder-length, it must be tied back with a rubber band.
